Flight Training

It is essential that all pilots operate their R/C model aircraft in a safe and competent manner.

Student pilots must fly under the guidance of an instructor until they demonstrate the ability to safely fly a model aircraft on their own. Our club has several qualified instructors to get you started!

This provides insurance coverage, a quarterly magazine, and enables participation in regional, national, and international aeromodelling events.
